REGIONAL

160km North, South, East and West of Bendigo

Based around the Bendigo Regional Tourism framework, the Bendigo region provides some of the best food producers in Victoria. Influenced by the 160km food source model, there are many benefits from working together to build a stronger food industry. The sharing of regional knowledge help cooks and chefs plan their menus focusing on the cultural heritage around our local food journey.

SEASONAL

Summer, Autumn, Winter and Spring

By coming together, local producers can provide members and the wider community with a better understanding of what is in season and when, therefore embedding a genuine understanding of food seasonality. Seasonal Showcase Sessions are held to help members identify produce that is available. Shared knowledge can inform the development of special events, marketing ideas or new dishes on the menu.

PROMOTION

Working together to create events and marketing ideas

The network allows for relationships and partnerships to develop at a local level stimulating the creation of new food concepts, events and marketing initiatives. Food Fossickers explores partnerships to attract visitors, identify funding opportunities and encourages spending in the region. Media opportunities are also sought to relay and share the stories of members.
